

Cornell School Board District Goals 2019- 2020

1. **Maintain at least a 25% Fund 10 Balance. Treat the district as a business.**
2. **Increase focus on curriculum:**
 - A. Develop/review curriculum scope & sequence in all areas K-12.
 - B. Implement a year-end reward & quarterly “grade & attendance rally”. The specifics on the rewards are to be determined by the staff members & not just the administration.
3. **Class Size & Instructional Levels:**
 - A. Any class size at 25 students or above must be discussed with the Board. This needs to be done before the matrix is finalized.
4. **Focus on team building with both the student body and district staff:**
 - A. Make sure students learn, work, & play in group/team environment.
 - B. Get staff to work together as teams – explore “school culture” for teachers & staff to work together. Build Professional Learning Communities (PLC’s)
5. **Maintain/increase school pride – Sell what we do best:**
 - A. Build school and community pride and spirit.
 - B. Annual board hosted appreciation event.
6. **Support extra-curricular activities:**
 - A. Allow 6th grade students in JH sports when athletes are needed and costs do not increase.
 - B. Continue to explore opportunities for non-athletic ventures – Science Olympiad, Dance, Pep/Jazz Band, Forensics, Drama, Debate, Academic Decathlon, etc...
