Mr. Elliott reported on the career planning discussion that took place during in-service.


Dr. Schley reported that the Elementary School received the School of Recognition Award. He stated that this is the 5<sup>th</sup> year in a row that the elementary has received this award.


Mrs. Sikora will be attending a WASB conference this week.
